## CHANGES IN THE CALL GUIDELINES ADDRESSED TO NORWEGIAN CONTEMPORARY ART ARTISTS

Oslo, 08th of June 2021

CHAPTER 1 – GENERAL INFORMATION – PHASE 2, ARTICLE 1 modifies from

1. *Recommendation letter from the Romanian person living with HIV with whom the Norwegian artists talked online in PHASE 1. The letter of recommendation will be given by that specific person.*

**TO**

No recommendation letter. Therefore ARTICLE 2 – ARTIST STATEMENT – becomes ARTICLE 1

The Norwegian artists accepted in PHASE 2 of the selection process WILL NOT send a recommendation letter from the person in Romania living with HIV with whom the artists talked online. This decision have been taken starting from the fact that all Norwegian artists benefited from an online discussion organized by Zebel Design Fishbain Norway and Semper Musica Association Romania, at which 4 persons living with HIV in Romania have participated, none of the Norwegian artists being put in the situation to organize their own meetings.
